

NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
FOR HIGHWAY 413 PRELIMINARY DESIGN AND ASSESSMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
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The Project

The Highway 413 Project will connect Highway 400 in the Regional Municipality of York to Highway 401 and Highway 407 Express Toll Route (407 ETR) in the Regional Municipality of Halton and the Regional Municipality of Peel. The completed corridor will create a total of 59 kilometres (km) of new highway infrastructure, including the 52 km Highway 413 corridor, a 4 km extension to Highway 410, and a 3 km extension to Highway 427, as well as 11 interchanges at municipal roads. Features such as stormwater management ponds, carpool lots, commercial vehicle inspection facilities and maintenance facilities have been included in the Preliminary Design. This key map shows the location of Highway 413 and extensions to Highway 410 and Highway 427.



Draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report

In accordance with Section 6 of the *Highway 413 Act, 2024*, a draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) has been prepared to describe the Preliminary Design of the Highway 413 Project. The report outlines the various alternatives considered, the environmental studies completed for the Project and describes potential environmental impacts as well as proposed mitigation measures. It also includes record of consultation that summarizes the consultation and

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engagement carried out with Indigenous communities, regulatory agencies, stakeholders, and the public in respect of the Project's Preliminary Design.

The draft EIAR is available on the Project Website for comment from **December 1, 2025 until January 6, 2026**. Comments on the draft EIAR can be provided via the Project Website, Project Email or Project Telephone Number.
